

Internet Explorer – Clear Website Data

Description

The Internet Explorer (IE) cache temporarily stores images, scripts, and other parts of websites you visit in order to speed up your browsing experience.

Resolution

To resolve this issue, please do the following:

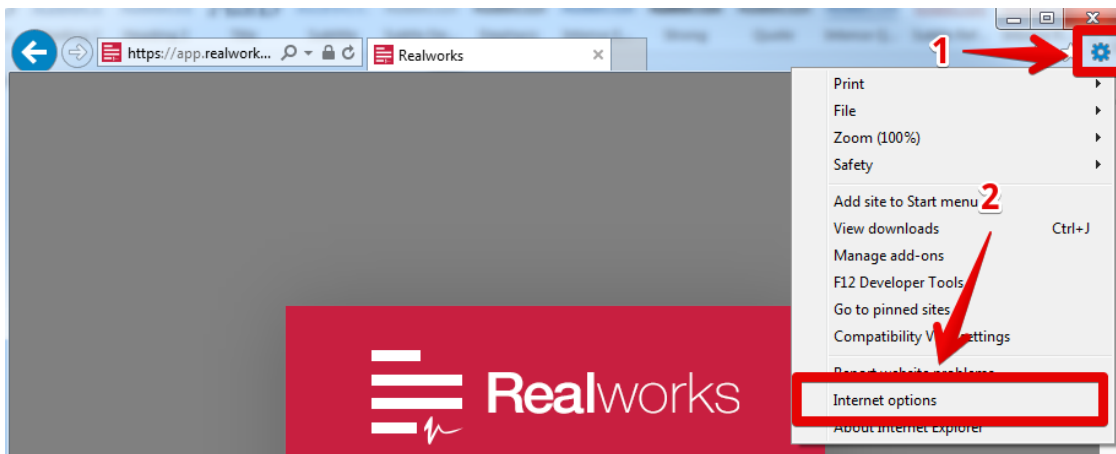


Figure 1 – Internet Explorer Menu

1. In IE, click the menu button and choose “Internet Options” – see Figure 1

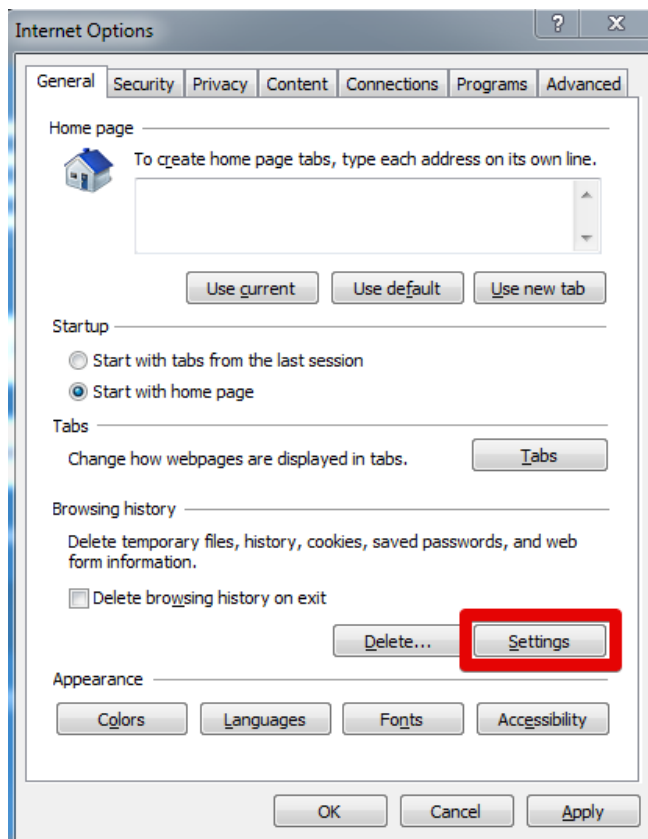


Figure 2 – Internet Options

2. Select “Settings” – see Figure 2

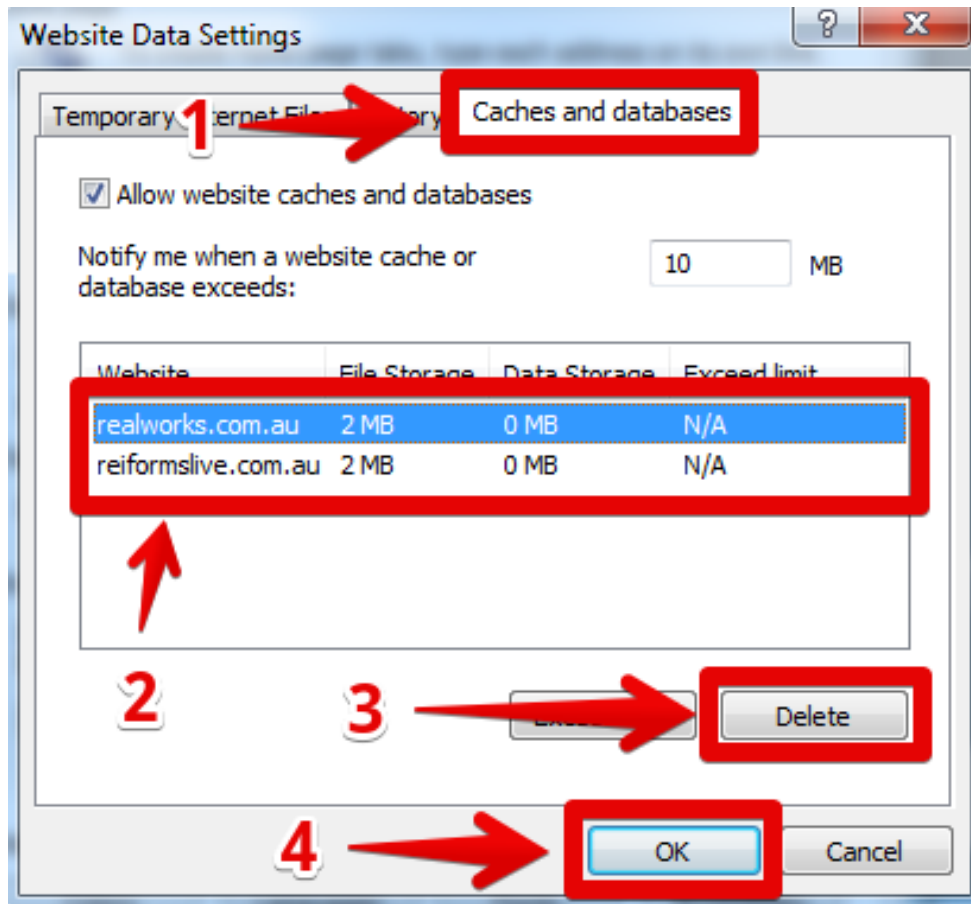


Figure 3 – Website Data Settings

3. Click the “Caches and databases” tab – see Figure 3
4. From the list that appears, select a site name that matches any of the following:
 - realworks.com.au
 - reiformslive.com.au
5. Click the “Delete” Button
6. Repeat for any other matching site
7. Click “OK”

NB: If “OK” is not clicked, IE will not delete the entries correctly and the above steps must be repeated.
